## 2020 BOARD WORKER APPLICATION

### ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

I, \_\_\_\_\_ understand that I **MUST** have a dependable mode of transportation to work as a Mercer County Board Worker. I **UNDERSTAND** that I **MAY be REQUIRED to move from one polling location assignment to another** to prevent voter disenfranchisement. I **UNDERSTAND** the Board of Elections Staff are the **ONLY** ones that can re-assign Board Workers. Moreover, I **UNDERSTAND** the **Master Board Workers** serve as an extension of the Board of Elections staff and have the **FULL AUTHORITY to RE-ASSIGN a Board Worker** according to the **NEEDS** of the Board of Elections to prevent the **DISENFRANCHISEMENT** of voters on the day of election.

I also **UNDERSTAND that I MUST HAVE A DEPENDABLE MODE OF TRANSPORTATION IN ORDER TO PICK UP AND DROP OFF BOOKS AND THAT I MAY NOT PICK UP BOOKS FROM THE MUNICIPAL CLERK WITHOUT PROVIDING A CURRENT and VALID FORM OF ID.**

**FURTHERMORE**, this signed application truthfully states and/or affirms: **1.** the applicants name and address; **2.** the applicant's date of birth; **3.** the political party to which he/she belongs to; **4.** that the applicant is of good moral character and has not been convicted of any crime involving moral turpitude; and **5.** that the applicant possess the following qualifications: eyesight with or without correction, sufficient to read size 6 font type; ability to read English language readily, the ability to write legibly with reasonable facility; **ability to lift 25 lbs.** and **MUST have a reasonable knowledge of the duties to be performed by the applicant as an election officer under the election laws of the State of New Jersey.**

Failure to comply with the rules and regulations of the Mercer County Board of Elections

**WILL RESULT IN IMMEDIATE TERMINATION.**

### MANDATORY TRAINING

According to **NJSA 19:50-1**: A board worker **MUST** receive instructional training **30 days** before an election administered by the County Board of Election. **These trainings MUST be given EVERY 2 YEARS, unless there is a change in the title 19 election laws and therefore, a MANDATORY training (regardless of most recent training) MUST be conducted.**

**NOTE: The Board MAY decide and has the authority to add more training if a need presents itself.**
