CALL TO ORDER:

The meeting of the East Windsor Township Council was called to order by Mayor Janice S. Mironov at 5:30 p.m. on Tuesday, July 29, 2025.

Approving of Filing Grant Application with the New Jersey Department of Transportation for the Local Aid Infrastructure Fund 2026 Grant Program

RESOLUTION R2025-147 EAST WINDSOR TOWNSHIP MERCER COUNTY

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Department of Transportation is soliciting grant applications under the Local Aid Infrastructure Fund 2026 program; and

WHEREAS, East Windsor Township desires to submit a grant application for improving the condition of Township roadways.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Council of the Township of East Windsor, in the County of Mercer, State of New Jersey, that:

- 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to submit an electronic application identified as "LAIF-2026-East Windsor Township Improvements to Abbington Drive and Other Streets Phase 2" on behalf of East Windsor Township, to the New Jersey Department of Transportation under the Local Aid Infrastructure Fund 2026 grant program.
- 2. The Mayor is hereby authorized to sign the grant agreement on behalf of East Windsor Township and her signature constitutes acceptance of the terms and conditions of the grant agreement and approves the execution of the grant agreement.

Mayor Mironov indicated the Wiltshire Park basketball resurfacing invoice should be charged to the park improvement grant. On the Developer Agreement bills list, she stated the Dutch Neck Road invoice should be charged to the appropriate grant.

Mr. Whittington raised an invoice to Custom Bandaq on the garbage bills list and pointed out the description and asked for more information.

Mayor Mironov requested staff check the balance of the legal fees account after processing the Kluger Healy bill.

It was MOVED by Russell, SECONDED by Whittington to approve the various Bills lists with the requested holds and clarifications.

MATTERS BY COUNCIL:

Mayor Mironov noted that the Hickory Corner Pathway sidewalk bill should be charged to the grant. The Township had a quote to repair the sidewalk from Hickory Corner Road to the pedestrian bridge from Green Rock Landscaping for \$14,832 and asked for Council agreement to proceed with the work, charge to the state \$1.3 million grant and list and list a Resolution on the next regular meeting agenda. Council members were in agreement.

Mayor Mironov indicated that a park inventory should be done of the benches, tables, etc.
