**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER X, "TRAFFIC," SECTION 10-3
"PARKING," SUBSECTION 10-3.5 "PARKING OF TRUCK, TRUCK
TRACTORS, TRAILERS AND CERTAIN RECREATIONAL VEHICLES," OF
THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF EAST
WINDSOR**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP
OF EAST WINDSOR** in the County of Mercer and the State of New Jersey, that
Chapter X, "Traffic," Section 10-3 "Parking," Subsection 10-3.5 "Parking of Truck,
Truck Tractors, Trailers and Certain Recreational Vehicles," of the Revised General
Ordinances of the Township of East Windsor is hereby amended as follows (deleted
sections are noted by strikethroughs, new sections are underlined):

I

1. Chapter X, "Traffic," Section 10-3, "Parking," Subsection 10-3.5 "Parking of Truck,
Truck Tractors, Trailers and Certain Recreational Vehicles," is hereby amended as
follows:

No truck with two rear axles or more, truck tractors, utility, trailer, semi-trailer or pole
trailer, snowmobile, all-terrain vehicles or house-type trailer or house-type semi-trailer as
defined in Title 39 in the Revised Statutes of New Jersey shall be parked overnight on
any ~~public roadway or right of way in any residential district~~ street of the Township of
East Windsor, between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m., except for the purpose of
emergency repairs. No utility, semi-trailer, trailer, house-type trailer, house-type semi-
trailer or pole trailer shall be parked on any ~~public roadway or right of way in any
residential district~~ street other than when attached to a towing vehicle

II

REPEAL

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby
repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

III

SEVERABILITY

If any section, subsection, clause or phrase of this ordinance is held to be
unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the remaining
portions of this ordinance.

IV
EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall take effect 20 days after final passage and publication according to law.
